UPON an application having been made by the Applicant dated 23 July 2026

AND UPON reading the Witness Statement of Frederick David John White dated 15 July 2026

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. An interim payment on account and without prejudice to the final fixing of remuneration at the conclusion of the proceedings is made to the Administrator in respect of remuneration for services rendered for the period from 1 April 2026 up to 30 June 2026 in the amount of £260,597.90, with such sums to be drawn from the administration estate.
2. The requirement for formal service upon individual creditors be dispensed with, and publishing of the application on the administration website, together with the supporting evidence and any Order made by the Court, shall instead constitute adequate notice to creditors, with separate notice to be made to the Gibraltar Financial Services Commission.
